



Specialist tour operator **Greaves Travel** offers several itineraries in India, the latest highlight being the new Jawai Leopard Camp in Rajasthan. Situated between Jodhpur and Udaipur in a relatively unexplored region of outstanding beauty, the camp (pictured) has eight luxurious tented suites. While sightings of leopards in India are never guaranteed, the probability of seeing them here is unusually high and a local reservoir attracts migratory birds.
